Opportunities and Requirements for Financial Aid

All tuition and fee amounts are subject to change by the Institution's Administrators.

The Institution desires to assist all eligible students who seek financial aid in order to continue with their education. Students may enter class only after payment of their tuition and fees has been arranged. The student may arrange to pay all costs of attendance by making full payment prior to beginning their program or make payments at established intervals (weekly, monthly) while enrolled in a program.

Students that are eligible for federal financial aid will have the total award amount applied to tuition and fees before calculation of the payment plan.

The primary purpose of student financial aid is to provide resources to the student who would otherwise be unable to pursue a post-secondary education. The financial assistance program is intended to supplement the student and their family's effort to meet the educational costs.

To be considered for any type of financial aid at this Institution, students must complete a "Free Application for Federal Student Aid" every program year. A student must also be accepted by the Institution and enrolled in an eligible program. In most cases, only students that are citizens or eligible non-citizens may apply for financial aid.

Financial assistance is awarded on a first come, first serve basis, therefore, it is recommended that eligible students begin the application process as early as possible.
